Si Adi Agom Dictionary emnam kitab si ngokke miinam kepe Herbert Lorraine delokke W.Savidge binyike 'Abor Miri Dictionary' emla ilena 1902 lo publish nam kitab kekonlo si kerang yalumpe Adi Dictionary pe lendupe midung. Lorrain buluke ilennam kitab si akon agomem kénmana miboe kéndope emla inam gomungsuneko. Agí Adi Agom kénnam legangpe bojerungko porinem si agér bito.

Supak si 'Abor Miri Dictionary' emnamsim leríngpe bomdola 'Adi Agom Dictionary' ko angukon gomungsune ko ikítungku. Adi Agom Dictionary ko ikupe aido emla ako annyi mantine kadung. Depe ila sim ikísirungpe ikílentung. Supakke Adi kíangko iskul porina kídíe Adi Agom kénsu yimana kídíe sim matayeku. Illeñ sianglo atí takame apíng malado. So irumso kitab sim aménako itung. Adi Agom takame so kayinkai emlamang. Si supakke nunemane (general) ponam agom gompíem basila ilentung. Sok kekon lokom agom gompíe bojeko kadung, dem méelamlo kaabom dola kénna kídíe iboyeku. ### Gender (Luube)

In Adi usage also like English, three genders are used; common gender (Dajam luube), Female Gender (Ane luube) and Male Gender (Abo luube). Most of the Adi usage of gender, male and female are differentiated suffixing at the end of common gender word with ‘bo’ and ‘né’

## Usage of Noun in numbers (Biidung)

- (a) Generally in order to indicate plural number, in Adi the word, kídí or kídár is added to end of noun. Say, ekii kídár, amikídí.
- (b) In order to show the collective noun, in Adi the word, ‘alung’, ‘alek’, ‘abam’, ‘abyak’ delokke ‘atíng’ are used.

### Example:

Ami alung	=	milung, mibam, mitíng
Ekkam alek	=	kamlek
Gooru abam	=	rubam, rutíng
Pettang abyak	=	taabyak, tatíng

## Usage of Adjective (Erki)

The general definition of Adjective is that it is the word that qualifies a noun. In Adi agom adjective word comes before noun and sometimes it comes after noun.

### Example:

*Aina ami, atímana doolung, bottena esing, kampona mime.* Here words *atímana*, *aina*, *bottena*, *kampona* are adjective come before noun. But sometimes adjective comes after noun word and it becomes one word.

### Example:

Ami + aku	=	miku
Ami + ani	=	mini
Ami+peebeng	=	mibeng
Ami + aro	=	miro
Ami + Martana	=	mikir/kaníng
Ami + yakana	=	mika

## Adjective of Comparison (Luplesunam Erki)

There are three degree of comparison as positive (Rungki), Comparative (Ruupeng) and Superlative (Kereng). Positive is the adjective word. When it compares with another for better or worse, then the word ‘than’ is used in comparison. In the same way, we measure with another, we use the word, ‘empemilo’ or ‘empenem’ before adjective positive word and ‘yado’ is suffixed at the end of the word. The word ‘yalumdo’ or ‘yalumna’ is added in order to show the superlative degree.

**Usage of Adverb (Ngumtem)**

The general definition of adverb is that the word qualifies the manner of adjective. In Adi, in order to indicate Adverb 'pé' is suffixed generally at the end of a verb or adjective

*Example:*

Affirmative in future

The verb that gives assurance are affirmative words

*Example:*

1. ngo dem *iyemangalo*
2. bí dem *kaadupiam*
3. nolu kénmape *ipíaya*

**Usage of Conjunction (Sonsu)**

It is the word that connects or separate two sentences (gomyar) *Say, delokke, idola, idakkom, lang demangkom, imilo*

*Example:*

Gooru delokke esoe lekope yebosudung

Or

Goorue lang esoe notko atello yedung

Bí kamponako idakkom bí kiyarnako

Opande murkong ete kamang demangkom

Donam ete kamang.

Bí aamilo, ngo gígeye

Anyat apim si amílem tolmodung idola donyinge idung

**Interjection (Mamam)**

It is the term for word uttered out of emotion

*Say, Abah, ei, oh, wah, eh, ayah, uloi, ah*

*Example:*

Eh! Kookone asiem toopak tokéne!

Uloi! Doonyie kaalangka, ngom monaism!

Wah! Silo gudorung!

Ayah! Akii kiname!

Ei! Nom koo nom ngo kaado!

Ah! Dem ipe manamkuwai!

Abah! Bípak ngom depe lubangmang

Abeh! Asi si engomíli!

Oh! Ami si ngom míngki namko kado namai!

Pronoun (*Bíidum*) is the term used in place of noun. In the usage of Adi/ Mishing language, in the singular number third person when used subject, the third person, the pronoun *bí* is also used along with the subject in case of a person.

*Example:*

Dr. Manmohan Singh bí India sokke Prime Minister e.

Dr. APJ Abdulkalam bí India sokke President e.

Mrs. Sonia Gandhi bí Congress President pe ikaku.

When we use noun objectively, generally *em* or *me* is used and do sometimes understood.

*Example:*

Shedík bí asi amongem pírongem taniem píto.

Ngo apim doto. Ngo ekum moto.

The word here *em* is silent and understood. Because here apimem and ekumem are hidden.

**Preposition (Rutem):**

It is the word that makes sentence complete sense. It gives the condition, character of the sentence.

E.g. *imílo*, '*kín*', *lo*, *lok*, *mangkom*, *kom*.

*Example:*

Arík ibone kimílo arígem iramdo.

Ngo Itanagarkíng gíla Guwahati endak.

Eyok lok arík padó.

Supakkom omesi ipdungada.

Abu mangke anede ekum rutume.

**Tense (Toodí) Signifies the time of Verb (Engun):**

Like English *toodí* is divided into past (yeruk toodí), Present (yedo toodí) and future (yeeye toodí). In Adi agom usage in order to show the present regular verb 'do' is suffixed with the verb, and for future *ye*, *pe* are always suffixed at the end of verbal word.

**Promisory Verb:**

It is the word that indicates promise for action whether past, present or future and either negative or positive sense, say '*rung*'.

*Example:*

Osunam omeoo dem ane abue ayangruto (past), ayang rudung or rudo (present), ayang ruye (future).

Emo domemsuna amide sika berok (past), sidung berok (present), siye berok (future).

**Probable verb:**

It is the word of action only for the future either in negative or positive sense, say *pemin*, *pelanga*, *yedi*, *madí*

*Example:*

Loobakna amide arík lokom empelanga! (future).

Kina amide silo hajirang yedudí yemadí! (present).

Melokom bí iskul aatodí aamadí! (past).

**Warning of words verb:**

*Ipelo*, *isona*, *ikiotoka*. The first two words are used for advice type of warning, and the third word is used for challenge.

Some of the root words of Adi agom

The above 43 words are sufficient to show how Adi word expands. There is basically one word. Usually, the syllable of the basic word is taken out in order to form different characters of noun or verb. For example, the basic word is ‘Amig’ and this word creates *migsi*, *mikkam*, *migbyong*, *migyod*, *migké*, *migbung*, *migri*, *migmol*, *migdar*, *migmang*, *migbik*, *migkuk*, *migololo*, *migyo*, *migmit*, *migbe*, *migsing*, *miglong*, *migkong* and *migyak*.

You see even the only one word *amig* has produced 20 characters of the same word. There may be many examples of the same kind. When we understand the word character then only it is easy to understand the Adi Dictionary (Gomusune).
