Bòblák	Group of people from the same family living together	M	Name given by the father when he is happy with the increase in family members
Bòbwiṅ	Good to have people	M	Name given to children when the family is small to encourage further children
Bòṅsá	Reconciling	F	Name given to encourage reconciliation
Bòónzùm	Handsome man	M	Name given to a child because the mother married the father just because of his appearance
Bòóṅwí	God's goodness	F	Name given to a female child to thank God for a safe delivery
Bòróbuin	Deceiver	M	Name given to a child to expose the father's untrustworthy habits
Búótè'	Father lost by death	F	Name given to a female child after the death of the father
Dzámnwí	Believe in God	F	Name given to a child to encourage the family to believe in God
Fánwí	God has given	F	Name given to a female child in appreciation of God's offer of more children
Gùṅgwí	God's making	M	Name given to a child accepting God's decision
Kàyuṅàmòkw	Do not be envious	M	Name given to a child to discourage longstanding envy
Kpásónwí	Thank God	F	Name given to a girl child when the parents have no children or only boys
Ndōgù	Bad luck in marriage	F	Name given to a child after the mother has had several unsuccessful marriages
Nèmfò	Where do I keep him?	M	Name given to a child after several deaths in the family
Nèmkù	Inheritance	M	Name given to a child who will inherit the family [?] when the father dies
Ɔkánjò	to confess	M	Name given to a child following deaths of children of family members to encourage the child to survive
Ɔdùdzè'	Warrior	M	Name given to a child born during a dispute
Ɔwìgha'buin	God is above man	M	Name given to a child born after every human remedy has failed

Bíbì	Second son	M	Name given to the second son of twins
Bùinwí	Brother to twins	M	Name given to the younger brother of twins
Mábì	Mother of twins	F	Name given to a woman who has given birth to twins
Ɔwáádèṅ	first daughter	F	Name given to the first daughter of twins
Ɔwáfés	second daughter	F	Name given to the second daughter of twins

Tàkù	First son	M	Name given to the first son of twins

Játóṅ	Light complexion	M	Name given to a man who is light in complexion
Kwàándùèṃ	Dark and short	F	Name given to a woman who is dark and short
Kwāndē	Lively	F	Name given to a lively woman
Nàmbwèṅ	Fat and healthy	F	Name given to a fat and healthy woman
Njāṅwoḍ	Fast growing	F	Name given to a fast growing girl
Dùnjó	Troublemaker	M	Name given to a troublesome man
Dùṅkàk	Dancer	M	Name given to a man who loves dancing
Wáṅkpú	Cry death	F	Name given to a woman who mourns too much at a death
